

Policy Document on Environment and Energy Usage

Dudhnoi College adheres a rigid policy towards environment and its use of energy. Its main objectives are to minimise the impact of our activities on environment and to explore the renewable energy sources. The policy applies to the whole institution and is binding for all the components of the institution; and applies to all its stakeholders and to the various activities undertaken by the institution. It will help us to create environmental awareness into our everyday activities, and increase responsibilities and commitment to conservation of natural resources and to limit its usage.

Policies:

1. To assess our energy usage and measure its impact on the environment
2. To count CO2 emissions generated by our vehicles and activities.
3. To reduce local air pollution emissions using environment-friendly vehicles, including bicycles and use of pedestrian-friendly roads.
4. To install photovoltaic solar panels for the generation of alternate energy
5. To install LED bulbs in the complete campus to save energy.
6. To switch off lights, fans in conference rooms, classrooms, lecture halls when they are not in use. Avoid use of decorative lighting
7. To develop systematic waste management mechanism.
8. To undertake tree plantation drive
9. To offer opportunities for employees and students to engage with environmental protection.
10. To reduce noise levels in the college so as to create a peaceful environment for learning.

Policy on Waste Management


Dudhnoi College

Dudhnoi College emphasises on keeping the campus clean and green through implementing an efficient way for waste management. Bio-degradable, non-biodegradable and chemical waste are managed properly so that it cannot pose any threat to nature and the environment of the college.

The following policy is used for that effect:

1. All the department and important places of the college will be facilitated with dustbin of the following categories:
 - a) Green colour dustbin– For biodegradable, organic waste like cooked food, vegetables, fruit, leaves, etc.
 - b) Blue colour dustbin– For recyclable waste like paper, cartons, cans, metallic items, etc.
 - c) Red colour dustbin – For non-degradable waste like glass, blades, expired medicine, bandages, etc
2. A pit will be made in the remote corner of the college to dump wastage from canteen and hostels.
3. Bio-degradable wastage will be converted to fertiliser and will be used for gardening.
4. For liquid waste, proper drainage system will be used to channelise the wastage to outside sewage system.
5. Collection and disposal of all non-biodegradable solid waste will be outsourced to authorised agencies. MoU will be signed to this effect.
6. All the re-cyclable biodegradable will be disposed to outside agency for recycle.
7. E-waste like computers, CCTV etc will be kept in storeroom before finally it is disposed.
