(The Abrogation of Article 370 and Contemporary Kashmir)

On 5th August, 2019, Article 370 of the Indian constitution has been abrogated to revoke special status or autonomy of Jammu and Kashmir. Jammu and Kashmir was bifurcated into two union territories of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh on that day. It has resulted into struggle from political parties who vowed for the restoration of statehood in the region. To have a scholarly discussion on this burning issue, the department of Political Science, Dudhnoi College in association with Centre for Ethnic Studies and research (CESR) organized a national webinar on 30th July, 2020 on the issue "The Abrogation of Article 370 and Contemporary Kashmir". The webinar was held through the online platform application zoom. Dr. Bolin Hazarika, retd. HoD, Political Science of J.B. College, Jorhat inaugurated the webinar. Professor Jangkhongam Dounge, HoD, Political Science of Mizoram University was present as resource person and delivered a thorough presentation on the issue. 

ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

Dudhnoi College is the manifestation of the collective dreams of people of the locality and the result of their aspirations and perspirations. The college is located in Dudhnoi, which is now headquarter of the Rabha Hasong Autonomous Council and is 110 km from Assam's capital city, Guwahati and 42 km from district headquarter town Goalpara. The College had a modest beginning with only Pre University (Higher Secondary) Arts classes in the year 1972. Degree classes of Arts stream started in 1974. Later on Science and Commerce streams were added in session 1985-86 and 2015-16 respectively. Presently the college has 18 different departments offering both Honours (Major) and Regular (General) Courses. The college has a pristine green and serene campus spreading over a vast area of 33.05 acres. A natural lake runs around the main building. A foot-bridge over the pond enhances the beauty

HOW TO REACH DUDHNOI COLLEGE:

Dudhnoi is well connected to the rest of the country by road and railway networks. It takes approximately two and a half hours from Guwahati city by roadway or railway. The institution is located less than 1 km from Dudhnoi Public Bus Station. The nearest airport is Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International (LGBI) Airport, Guwahati and the distance from LGBI Airport to Dudhnoi College is 91.2 km and can be reached via NH-17 (earlier NH-37).
