<u>Certificate Course on Aquaculture</u> offered by Department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College Session 2022

Goalpara district has about 9 lakh population. The socio-economic statuses of most of the peoples of the district are not sound and are living below poverty line. Majority of them earn their livelihood from agriculture and agro-based activities. Contrary to such socio-economic condition it has been found that the district has tremendous potentialities of aquaculture, having about 3970 hact. Lentic water bodies consist of 17 no.s Govt. Registered beel, 80 no.s unregistered beel, 39 no.s marshy land and water logs, and about 837 hact man made ponds. In addition the district also has about 250 square Km. Lotic water bodies. Preliminary studies have revealed that the majority of wetlands are with congenial environment for fish and non-Piscean aquaculture. Moreover, the district has a very good fish market with about 9 laces fish consumers of native peoples as well as the peoples from Meghalaya specially the west Garo hills district. Contrary to such situation, the fish production of its wetlands and beels are very poor which cover only about 30% of the local fish market. About 70% fishes are imported from nearby district and from other states. In addition to fishes majority of local peoples specially tribal peoples consume non Piscian species like Bellostoma (Giant water bug), crabs, several species of molluscs etc. But all such species are collected from natural habitat only. But due to gradual change of environmental scenario, over exploitation, anthropogenic interferences the population of these species are severely in declining condition. A series of studies has been conducted by the Department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College through different students' project works, field studies regarding the prospects and potentialities of fish culture, fish markets etc. And it has shown that though plenty of wetland and water bodies are in the district, they are not scientifically managed. The studies have also revealed that educated youths are not generally involved in fish culture and they are not even aware about the prospects of fish culture and non-Piscian aquaculture. Fish culture is still restricted among traditional fishermen and uneducated peoples.

In such situation, being a pioneer educational institution the Department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College has conducted a short term certificate course among the educated youths as well as among the interested youths on fish culture and non-Piscean aquaculture in collaboration with Grameen Sahara, Chhaygaon, Kamrup. The Grameen Sahara is an NGO with sufficient human resource and scientific aquaculture system like Biofolk culture and oil and water testing laboratory to provide required practical classes on aquaculture to trainces. The NGO is much more interested to boost up rural economy through aquaculture as it has been working in north East India specially the Tribal peoples of Assam, Meghalaya, Nagaland and Manipur.

Objectives: The Certificate Course on Aquaculture has been introduced with the following objectives-

- 1. To motivate the educated youth for scientific fish culture and self employment
- 2. To provide technical support and skill development for fish culture and non Piscian aquaculture.
- 3. To create employment generation through self employment and small scale farming
- 4. Entrepreneur development through fish and fishery product
- 5. Economic development of the society and contribute to the nutrition and health management of common peoples.
- 6. Sustainable utilization of wetlands and contribute to the restoration of natural environment.

Course Details:

The course was attended by 65 participants who were regular students of Dudhnoi College. Classes started on 11th May, 2022 till 25th May, 2022. Total 39 Hrs of classes have been taken in 13 days. Faculties of the department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College and Guest faculty from Grameen Sahara took classes on different topics like methods of fish culture, water quality management of tank, fish health and nutrition management, ornamental fish culture, non piscian species culture, advance methods in aquaculture, post harvest management and entrepreneur development etc. Participants were given hands on training on how to manage water quality and how to construct aquarium. Participants were taken on field visit to aquaculture farm at Grameen Sahara Bio-folk farm located at Chhaygaon, Kamrup. the certificate distribution ceremony. The principal addressed the students, saying that the students need to take maximum benefit from this type of certificate courses provided by the college. College takes pride in rewarding the students for their hard work and achievement must always be taken into consideration.



Course Outcomes: Major outcomes of this certificate course are-

- Participants got the opportunity to gain expertise in the seed production technology for cultured finfishes and crustaceans.
- Participants acquired hands-on training in water quality management of tank and construction of aquarium and thus skilled to propagate environment friendly and ecologically sustainable aquaculture practices.
- Participants became expertise in handling various instruments and technical aspects related to water/soil quality assessment thus resulting in solving issues in connection with quality management in culture systems.
- They got skilled to analyze the quality assessment and post-harvest technology to manage live fish and fishery products.
- Participants got the knowledge to manage and maintain aquaculture system on their own, either as an employee or at the level of an entrepreneur.

on Certificate Course on Beauty and Makeup Session: 2022



In this part, the students will get an idea about different strategies taken at international level for the protection and promotion of human rights. Here, special focus is given on the role of United Nations and the

UDHR in making the concept universal and international in nature. The second part deals with the concept of human rights from Indian perspective. The participants would come to know about the growth of human rights in India in different stages of history as well as in the present situation.

Course Details: Total 34 students got admitted into the course. Class has been started on 1st March, 2022 till 26th May, 2022. Total 36 contact hours of classes have been taken in 29 days. Teachers of the department of Political Science of Dudhnoi College and teachers from neighbouring colleges i.e. Bikali Collage, Dhupdhara and Habraghat Mahavidyalaya, Krishnai took classes. COURSE COMPLETION REPORT

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN SERICULTURE (MUGA CULTURE)

offered by Department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College (From 11th April to 4th June, 2022)

Muga silk is exclusive to the state of Assam in India with protected Geographical Indication (GI) Tag. The plantation of *som* in Dudhnoi College began in November of 2000. The *som* saplings were supplied by the sericulture farm of Balasara, Dudhnoi and the self-help group of the college began plantation in April, 2001. However the cultivation was discontinued for various reasons like inavailability of additional workers, etc. One of the challenges encountered during this period since its initial stage is the lack of expert supervision in the field of this practice. As per reports and research studies, this is a common problem encountered all over the state of Assam. In the year 2022, the muga silkworm rearing was revived by bringing in expert traditional muga silkworm rearers. In order to make the sericulture cultivation and production more familiar to the College students, the department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College offered a certificate course in "**Muga Culture**" from 11th April, 2022 to 4th June, 2022. The certificate programme was made available to all the students of Dudhnoi College with the aim of raising awareness of MUGA among the youths.

Objectives of the Course:

- Motivate the educated youths/ students for sericulture specially cultivation of Muga food plants, rearing of muga worms.
- > To motivate the youths for production of commercial muga seeds (eggs for rearing)
- > To generate self employment opportunity.
- > Restoration of eco-friendly environment through cultivation of som plant.
- Resource generation for sericulture industry through production of Muga cocoon and production of Muga seeds.

Course Details:

The department of Zoology, Dudhnoi College conducted the Certificate Course in Sericulture (Muga Culture) from 11th April to 4th June, 2022 for 16 days. Per day 2 hours classes have been taken and hence the course continued for 32 hours for both theory and practical. Total

300 students registered and participated in this course. The resource persons for this programme were the faculties of the Zoology department of Dudhnoi College. Dr. Tapan Ch. Kalita, Associate Professor of the department of Zoology has been appointed as the course coordinator to carry out all the required activities for smooth functioning of the course. This course mainly covers topics like introduction to sericulture; problems and prospects of sericulture in Assam, types of culturable silk moth in North East India, introduction to Muga (*Antheraea assama*) silk worm and its life history, different food plants of Muga silk worm, environmental conditions for Muga culture, food plants and its management, selection of seeds and its hatching, rearing of different instars, transfer of larvae from one food plant to other for feeding, preparation of cocoon building device and collection of mature larvae for cocoon formation, separation of pupae from cocoon and maintenance of adult moths for breeding and egg production, conservation of eggs for future culture etc.



Course Outcomes:

After completion of the Course

- Most of the participants got motivated for sericulture specially cultivation of Muga food plants, rearing of muga worms.
- > The participants came to know about the scientific rearing of Muga silk worm.
- Some students also became interested for post cocoon processing specially realing and spinning of Muga.
- This certificate course inspires the participants for further plantation of Som in their own land that will definitely help in restoration of eco-friendly environment.

Course Details:

Teachers from the department of Commerce and department of Computer Science of Dudhnoi College have taken theory and practical classes on subjects like Accounting, Rules of Debit and Credit, Trial Balance & Financial Statement, Inventory, Stock Groups, Stock Categories & Stock Items, Types of Vouchers, Balance Sheet, Financial Report etc.

Course Outcomes:

- The students got the knowledge to create company, enter accounting voucher entries including advance voucher entries, reconcile bank statements, do accrual adjustments, and also print financial statements, etc. in Tally.ERP 9 software.
- The participants acquired a clear understanding of accounting concepts and double entry system
- The students are able to possess required skill and can also be employed as Tally data entry operator.

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Course Co-ordinator Certificate Course on Tourism Studies

- 1. Title of the Practice: "Certificate Course on Vermicomposting and Mushroom Pultivation".
- 2. Objectives of the Course: The 'Certificate Course on Vermicomposting and Mushroom Cultivation' has been introduced by the department of Botany, Dudhnoi College with the objective to impart knowledge to the participants on manufacturing and production of mushroom and vermicompost.

The main objective of vermicomposting is to produce organic manure of exceptional quality for the organically starved soil by using agricultural wastes, garden wastes and animal farms waste. The other objectives of vermicomposting are like-

- > To make students understand the basic principles of vermicomposting, its types and classification.
- > To determine the factors that affects vermicomposting.
- > To know the process how vermicomposting take place.
- > To know how can vermicompost be used as a source of self-employment and to know the benefits of vermicompost.
- > To know the importance and soil nutritional value of vermicomposting.
- > To train up the skill of entrepreneurship development.

Mushroom cultivation or mushroom farming is now a days a source of earnings to common people for main two reasons-

1. Low investment and 2. High demand for mushrooms in the food sector.

The mushrooms have been revered in Eastern cultures for thousand years due to their health benefits as they are the source of many nutrients. Now-a-days mushrooms are considered as a high quality food because of its zero fat contents and high mineral contents along with essential vitamins.

The main objective of mushroom cultivation is to create awareness about the importance of this activity among students as well as common people of the locality to strengthen livelihood through the generation and to impart knowledge about such a fast yielding and nutritious source of food and a suitable source of income. The other objectives of this practice on mushroom cultivation are-

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- ➤ To provide information for students about the role of mushroom cultivation in supporting the local economy by contributing to subsistence food security, nutrition and medicine.
- > To develop marketing opportunities for indigenous mushrooms among smallholder farmers.
- > To impart knowledge about how to generate additional employment and income through local, regional and national trade.
- ➤ To provide information about to what extent mushroom cultivation is a viable and attractive activity for both rural farmers and peri-urban dwellers, since it does not require land for cultivation.

3. The Context:

Dudhnoi College is a premier educational institution of Assam catering to the academic needs of thousands of students every year. It is also shouldering responsibilities for opening avenues for its students through which they can make a respectful living after graduation. Keeping this view in mindthe department of Botany Dudhnoi college has been practising Vermicomposting and Mushroom cultivation since January 2021.

The IQAC of DudhnoiCollege has proposed to launch a series of certificate courses on value addition and skill development of its students. as a part of this larger process, the department of Botany in collaboration with ICAR-KVK, Goalparahas also organized a certificate course in "Vermicomposting and mushroom cultivation" for the students of the college and common public of the locality. The knowledge gained from this programme attracted our students to agriculture and farming as well as provided them the required proficiency in these field to explore the commercial potentiality of Dudhnoi and its neighbouring areas.

4. The practice:

In fact, considering the importance of significance of Mushroom (a healthy and nutritious food) and Vermicompost (an organic manure) in the present day context, the department of Botany, Dudhnoi College organised the certificate course in 'Vermicomposting and Mushroom cultivation' from 27th June to 9th July, 2022. From 27th June to 29th June

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registration of participants was done and from the 30th June classes were started which was ended on 9th July, 2022. Total 62 (Sixty two) participants coming from Dudhnoi, its neighbouring areas, Kamrup district and Meghalaya including the College students and some College employees made the programme a grand success.

Department of Botany has been maintaining the first unit of vermicomposting since January 2021, which consists of three tanks (1.5 quintal capacity of each). After completion of the certificate course, the department of Botany has set up one more unit of Vermicomposting i.e. Vermicomposting unit 2, which consists of two polybags(5 quintal capacity of each).

Faculty members, employees and students of the department all are actively involved in maintaining the whole process(Starting from production to marketing) of Vermicomposting.

Department has also been maintaining a Mushroom cultivation unit since January 2021. After completion of the certificate course, the department has been practising mushroom cultivation in regular basis. The honours as well as general students of the department are actively involved in the process of production of Mushroom starting from preparing straw up to harvesting of Mushroom.

Moreover, the department has been arranging different training programmes for the dwellers of the neighbouring villages to guide and encourage for Vermicomposting and Mushroom cultivation.

5. Evidence of Success:

As per some information we have received a considerable number of participants have engaged themselves in doing vermicomposting and mushroom cultivation after completion of the course and thus they are earning their livelihood.

The department of Botany itself has been selling the products of both Mushroom and Vermicompost maintained in the department. A sum of Rs 20340/-has been earned by the department by selling 678 Kg Vermicompost at the rate of Rs 30/- per Kg. Again a sum of Rs 4900/- has been earned by the department by selling 24.5 Kg Mushroom at the rate of Rs 200/- per kg.

Principal Dudhnoi College From the total earned money, the department has contributed Rs 5000/- to the College fund through the honourable Principal Dr. Lalit Chandra Rabha. The department has been maintaining the expenditure of the process of practising Vermicomposting and Mushroom cultivation from the rest part of the earned money.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

The department has received honourable principal's constant support and encouragement from every angle in implementing the practice of Vermicomposting and Mushroom cultivation. There are some limitations of Vermicompost such as

- It is a time consuming process i.e. it requires almost 4 months for decomposing the organic waste.
- It requires higher maintenance in comparison to traditional composting methods.
- Vermicomposting tanks have to be cool enough to support earthworm life.
- It requires man power.

The process of Mushroom cultivation has also some limitations such as

- It requires a favorable cultivation house.
- Unavailability of good spawn.
- In most of time spawns are found infected.
- At the time of vacation due to lack of manpower watering problem to mushrooms arises.
- Non availability of quality straw.

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Course Report on **Certificate Course in Yoga** Session: 2021-22.


