That spread of Covid-19 pandemic and its subsequent lockdown is unprecedented for the present generation of people. Only timely precaution and social distancing can prevent its fast spread in the society. As an Educational institute it is our duty to spread the message among the teachers and students to abide by the lockdown rules. The meeting is called to take certain decision formally. There is another purpose of the meeting too. Since lockdown cripples the movement of the people, so normal classes will remain closed. Given that situation, what will be the strategy of the college to meet the challenges.

Thereafter, the principal chaired the meeting and made it open for discussion. Before that, Dr. Lalit Ch. Rabha, principal, request all the members to follow the rules laid by Govt.of Assam, and spread the message of social distancing through digital platform to curb the rapid spread of Covid-19 virus. All teachers supported the principal's opinion. Taking this opportunity, Mr. Birbol Boro expressed his view that the present situation requires people to use mask and hand sanitizer to save themselves from being infected from the deadly disease, can Dudhnoi College fraternity extend its support to the people living nearby since these products are not yet freely available in the market yet. Replying to Mr. Boro's suggestion, Mr. Dibakar Nath told the meeting that science department can certainly help in this process. Department of chemistry can certainly produce hand sanitizer for distribution among the common people, if college authority can supply them raw products needed for manufacture of it. However, this can't be completed physically as coming to the College is not feasible in this lockdown.

With regard to the second agenda, Dr Mridutpal Goswami suggested that since most of the students possess smart phones, so online classes can be taken on free online platform like ZOOM and Google MEET. Adding to Dr. Goswami's opinion, Mr. Surjya Kumar Swargiary told in the meeting that can we develop a system, which can be centrally monitored and controlled. Ms. Shrutidhara Kashyap gave a solution to the discussion with the suggestion that if google meet can be integrated to the college website; and classes are conducted through a central routine, then the difficulties of teaching learning can be minimized to a great extent.

Upon meaningful discussions, the following resolutions have been adopted:

Resolution No: 1: It is unanimously resolved that college will produce hand sanitizer on its own and distribute it among the needy people. The chemistry department was given the responsibility to produce hand sanitizer.

The following discussions and decisions have been made in this meeting:

The meeting started with Dr. Bidyut Kalita explaining the purpose of the meet. In his speech, he stressed that the college reopens after a prolong lockdown. In this point of time, therefore, Dudhnoi college needs to readjust its strategy to tackle the challenges brought by this unprecedented event. This meeting is called to make strategy with due support from teachers.

The principal, Dr. Lalit Ch. Rabha, chaired the meeting and made it open for discussion. Taking this opportunity, Mr. Birbol Boro told the meeting that though lockdown has been relaxed to some extent, yet the danger looms large. We must take utmost precaution while taking classes. The whole campus needs to be sanitised and rules of social distancing must be followed. The day care centre must take heat reading of each student while entering the college with thermos reader.

Discussing the topic of management of classes, Mr. Shafiqul Hussain, Associate Professor, Department of English told that if all the students come to college on the same day, social distancing cannot be practically followed. Therefore, Mr. Hussain added that an alternate strategy must be made and the college class routine be changed to allow small number of students at one time on the college campus.

After meaningful discussion among the members, the meeting adopted the following resolutions:

Resolution No 1: All the teachers and students must go throw rapid antigen test before joining their service or coming to the college.

Resolution No: 2: Mr. Soumin Nath, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, will be appointed as coordinator of the Day Care centre, and the day care centre will ensure that every student through heat reading at the entrance of the college.

Resolution No 3: It has been resolved that only 30% of students will be allowed entry in the college at the same time in order to make social distance practically possible inside the college campus.

Meeting of the IQAC

Date: 12/10/2022

The following key points have been discussed in the meeting:

The meeting started with Dr. Bidyut Kalita, coordinator of IQAC, explaining the purpose of the meet. In his speech, he explained that mentoring process for the year 2021-22 has just been accomplished, though feedback from mentees is still awaited. At the same time, mentoring for the new session 2022-23 has also kicked off. Required instruction are made ready to be sent to the teachers and also necessary arrangements have been made to sensitize students about the importance of such system once again. In this point, IQAC would like to listen to opinion and suggestions of each esteemed members before starting the next cycle of mentoring of students. Dr. Kalita also drew attention of the members to re-set the SWOC of the college as many of the challenges and weakness defined by NAAC in its last A&A has been addressed properly.

In his explanation of the purpose of the meet, Dr. Kalita also seeks attention of the members that preparation of Self Study Report (SSR) requires details of the expenditure of the college; at the same time, it requires such data to be reflected in the annual financial audit of the college. However, from 2019-20 onward the audit of the college is yet to be completed, though the process is going on. In this regard, valuable opinion is sought from each member.

Thereafter, the principal chaired the meeting and made it open for discussion and suggestion from each of the members. Taking this opportunity, Ms. Linso Timungpii shared some of her insights and experiences as mentor that took place during the accomplishment of mentoring of students. She also suggests that little bit of modification is required in the instructional format that each mentor requires to keep against each student. Next to her, Dr. Mridul Dutta offers his opinion that mentoring really helped the teacher come close to his students and know them better, which eventually guides them well.

In regard to the SWOC of the college, the principal told the members that most of the weaknesses and challenges found earlier and recognized by NAAC have been addressed and turned into advantages. However, there are new challenges and weaknesses that still exist. In this regard, Mr. Dibakar Nath pointed out that still the college does not have a clear cut off marks at the time of admission of students. As a result, all those who have passed the qualifying examination with minimum marks are allowed admission, which affects classroom transaction later. Other members also supported in favour of a move towards imposing cut off marks. Upon that discussion, the principal explained that most of the departments have their own cut off marks for honours course. For regular course, there is no cut off marks yet, but will be imposed soon.

Ms. Bondita Borbora, joint coordinator of IQAC, continuing this discussion further, drew attention of the members to the fact that number of students coming for admission in science stream is not encouraging. The institution should attract more students to study science. To do this, Ms. Borbora suggests, one should remove fear from the mind of people towards science by developing interest towards it. For this, the college must come out of its comfort zone and reach out to the people living in the vicinity of Dudhnoi to inform them about the benefit of studying science through different programmes.

Thereafter, in his speech Mr. Birbol Boro wanted to know the progress that IQAC is making in submitting the SSR. Mr. Dilip Hazarika, joint coordinator of IQAC, informed the meeting that complete draft of Institutional profile along with extended profile and

executive summary has been prepared, and will be placed before the executive committee for scrutiny and correction soon. Mr. Hazarika also informed that all the

answers under qualitative metrics have been drafted and data for quantitative metrics are being collected and is in the final stage. Moreover, supporting documents for each kind of metrics are being serialized according to the metrics. Therefore, IQAC is hopeful that by 30 November 2022, the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) can be sent to NAAC.

After much discussions on each point of the agenda, the following resolutions have been adopted unanimously:

Resolution No 1: With slight modification in the existing mentoring format, the form will be distributed among departments by 15th November, 2022 for the academic year 2022-23. The IQAC will oversee the whole process.

Resolution No 2: The college authority will take stringent action to give cut off marks for admission into degree 1st semester from next academic year.

Resolution No 3: IOAC will plan and execute a series of extension and outreach activities to popularize science in the vicinity of Dudhnoi in 2022-23 academic year.

Resolution No 4: IQAC will take necessary measures to submit IIQA to NAAC for 3rd cycle of A&A by the end of November, 2022.

Action Taken

- The mentoring format has been distributed among the departments for the session 2022-23; and it has been successfully completed.
- Extensive activities have been carried out at different neighboring schools by various departments of the college. Department of Botany organized a workshop for the people of its adopted village to develop skills of mushroom cultivation.
